2. I will follow all traffic lights, street signs and road markings — and I will not exceed the speed limit.
34% of crash fatalities among 16- to 19-year-olds are speed-related.
3. I will never race or try to impress others by driving recklessly.
Car crashes are the #1 killer of teens.


Initial



I will not drive distracted.

1. I will keep both hands on the wheel at all times.
Reaching for a phone or other item while driving increases your risk of crashing nine times.
2. I will not use a cell phone in any way while driving.
Texting while driving makes it four times as likely you will cause a crash.
3. I will never use earphones to listen to an electronic device while driving.
16% of all fatal crashes for drivers under the age of 20 involve driver distraction.

Initial



I will abstain from drugs and alcohol.

1. I will only drive when I am drug and alcohol free.
In 2010, 22% of drivers aged 15 to 20 involved in fatal motor vehicle crashes were drinking.
2. I will never permit drugs or alcohol in my vehicle.

I will obey all _____ young driver laws.

1. I will not drive unsupervised until I am _____ years old.
Crash risk is especially high during the first few months of licensure.
